BASIC SOIL TYPES

ALLUVIAL

Deposited by ancient river flows, cobbly, stony, gravelly, excessively drained moderate to low nutrient content.

VOLCANIC

Formed by local volcanic flows. Mainly rhyolite and tuff, poor in nutrient and organic material, excessively to well drained.

SEDIMENTARY

Richer loamy soils formed by the settling of an ancient sea or lake. Can be poorly drained and have good nutrient and organic composition.

WINE CHARACTERISTICS of Cabernet Sauvignon

Earthy, aromatic, complex, and concentrated

Spicy, cedary, often minty

Ripe berry & fruity, can be herbal and strongly flavored
